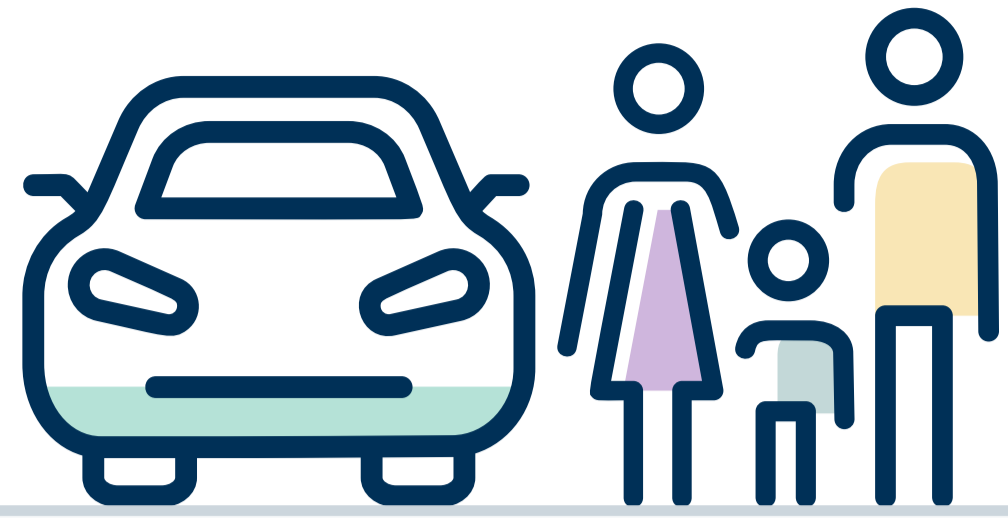


BUYING VS LEASING A CAR



6,000-12,000 MILES

If you drive between **6,000 and 12,000 miles/year, consider leasing** – the residual value goes down over 6,000 miles/year, but you'll want to avoid going over 12,000 miles/year because of overage fees.

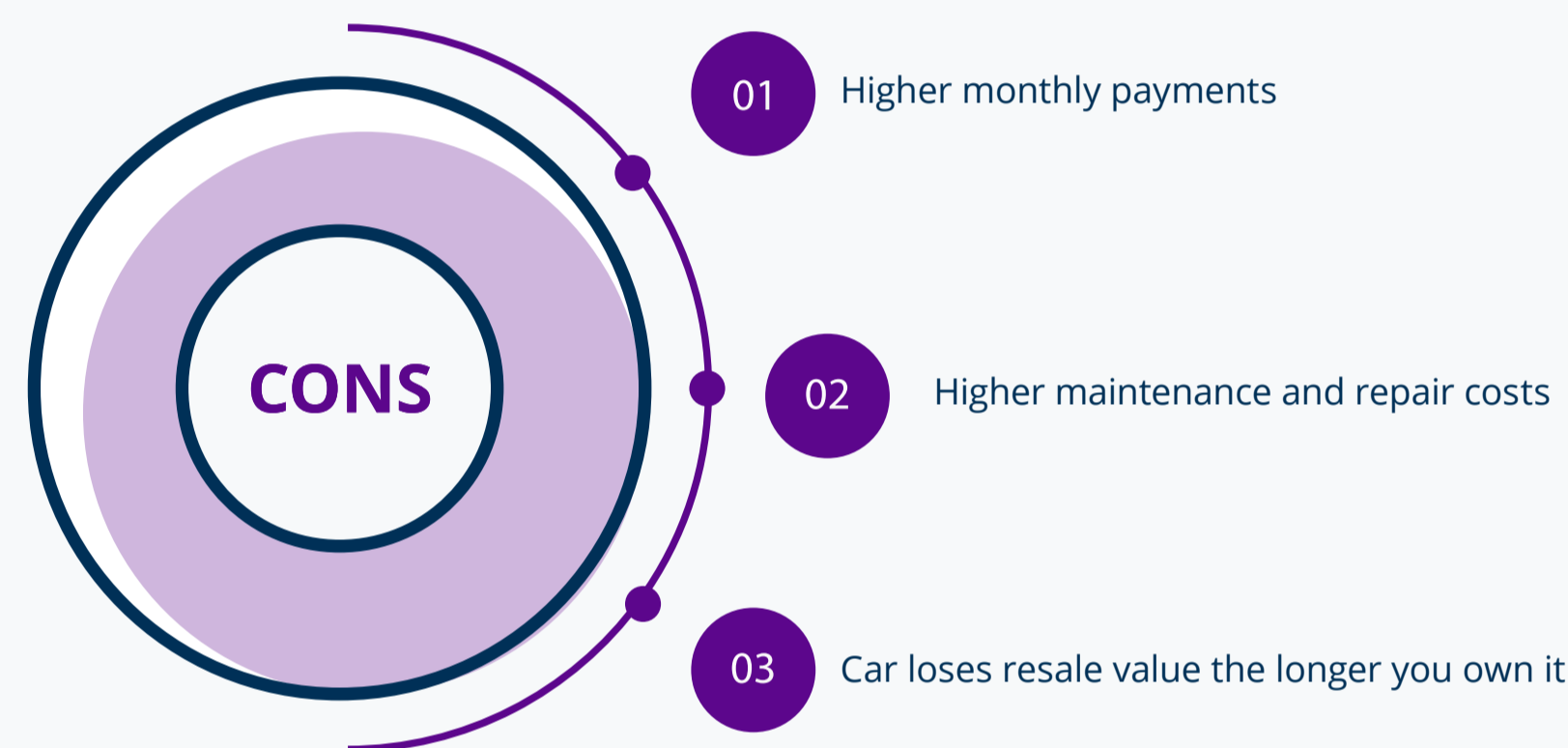
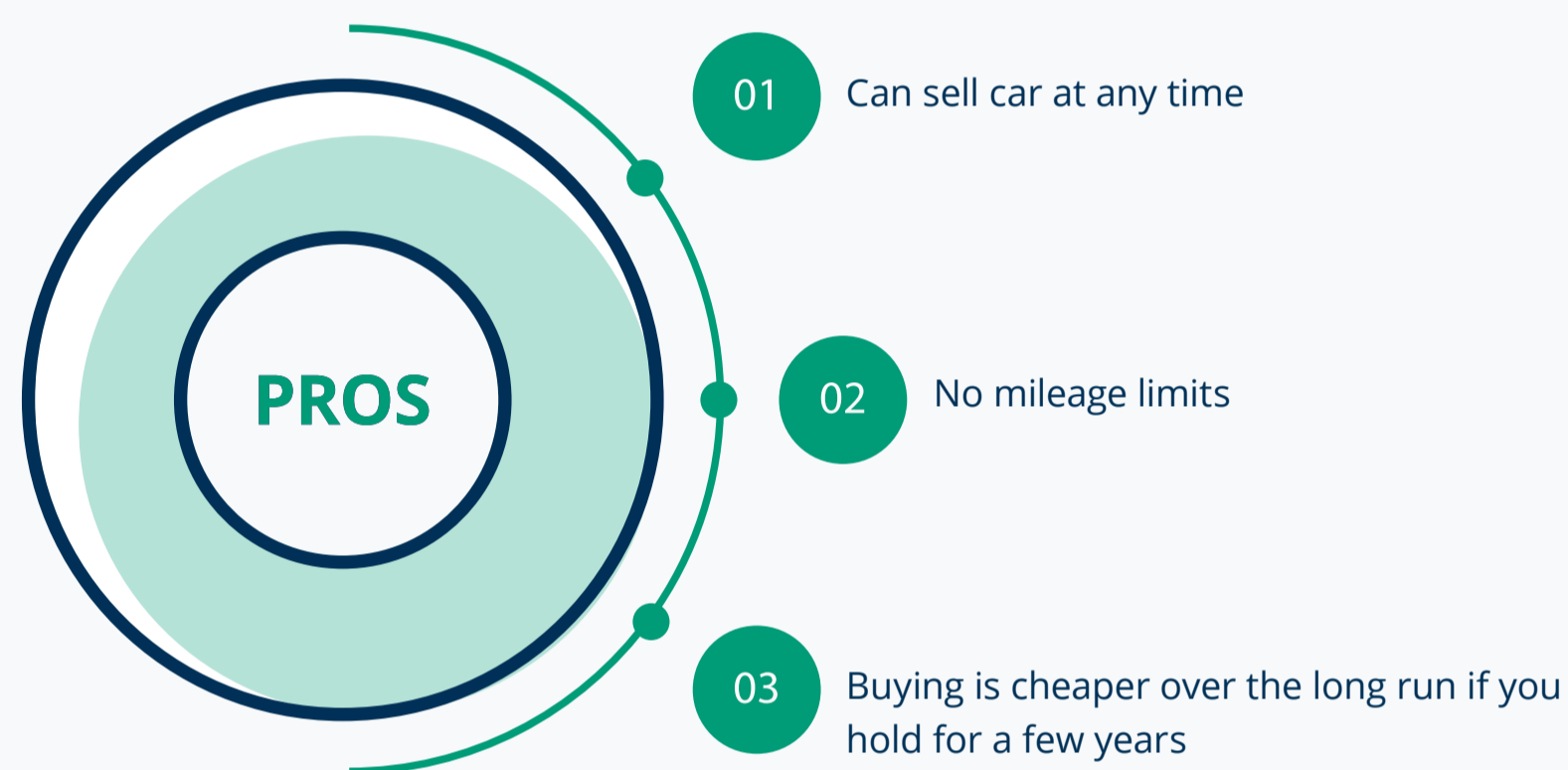
6,000 MILES & LESS

If you drive **under 6,000 miles/year, consider buying** – your residual value should be more than any lease projects because it's in such great condition.

12,000 MILES & GREATER

If you drive **over 12,000 miles/year, consider buying** – the cost of a lease gets prohibitive because the mileage over 12,000/year is very expensive on a per-mile-overage basis.
